Programs for FY2021

Below are a list of priority programs for the library. As you will see, all ages and a wide variety of interests are represented in the programs we are requesting.

Teen Advisory Committee

Goal: Get middle and high school students involved in library operations, program development, and materials selection. Teens will get an opportunity to develop teen-specific programs at the library, purchase library materials specific to teens, and lead monthly advisory meetings. Through this process they will learn about budget management, collection development, and more. This program was suggested to us by a teenage patron who was interested in participating.

2. Guest Speakers x3 per year

Funding to cover the cost of travel and basic expenses for visiting authors, performers, artists, or other presenters whose presentations align with the library's mission statement. We have communicated with several potential guests over the last couple of years, including musicians, astronomers, and authors. Without a budget for guest speakers, it has been difficult to make these opportunities happen, and we have turned down several opportunities that could have provided enrichment to our community.

3. Documentary showings x 5 per year

accommodate these requests if the interested parties are able to help us raise the funds for the screening. As this has been a recurring request from multiple community members, we would like to include it in our programs budget.
