



## The Municipal Election is Tuesday, October 6.

Gustavus voters may choose to vote using any of these available options:

- Absentee Voting by Mail:
  - Voters may submit an application to receive a ballot by mail. Ballots will be mailed mid-September and must be returned to the Municipal Clerk's Office before 8:00 p.m. on October 6 or be postmarked by October 6. The last day to request a ballot by mail is September 29.
- **Advanced Voting In-Person:** Voters may vote an early in-person ballot September 21 October 5 by appointment only at Gustavus City Hall Monday-Thursday 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Enhanced protective measures, along with social distancing, will support safe polls for poll workers and voters.
- **Voting by Personal Representative:** Voters who are unable to vote in person due to age, serious illness or disability may have a personal representative pick up a ballot beginning September 21. Contact the Clerk's Office for more information.
- **Election Day In-Person:** Voters may vote in-person on Election Day at the Gustavus Community Center. Polls will be open 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Enhanced protective measures, along with social distancing, will support safe polls for poll workers and voters.
