Library Closure Policy/Movement Between the Phases

- If COVID positive test results are announced in Gustavus, the library could move to **Phase 1** or **Phase 2** depending upon the situation (e.g., number of positive cases, possible contacts, connection to library, etc.).
- The library staff will determine movement between the phases in consultation with the Mayor, Incident Commander and/or City Administrator based on the current situation (e.g., number of positive cases, possible contacts, connection to library, etc.).
- The library may close at any time at staff discretion or under direction of the Mayor, Incident Commander and/or City Administrator.
