

GUSTAVUS PUBLIC LIBRARY INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

Internship dates: August 15-18, 2023 \$13.50/hr, up to 28 hours per week

This position opens for application on: August 2, 2023 This position closes for application on: August 9, 2023

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Assisting in planning and preparing Literacy Camp activities.
- Preparing materials ahead of time for each day's program.
- Setup and cleanup of daily activities.
- Assisting in daily programs, and leading activities such as read-alouds and games with children under the supervision of library.
- Recording data, taking photos, and assisting children with literacy camp activities.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be at least 14 years of age.
- Applicants must be reliable, self-starters, and able to work well with children and families.
- Applicants must be available August 15-18, from 8:30am-3:30pm.
- Must be able to show up on time and work with enthusiasm and effort.

Work Hours:

August 15-18, from 8:30am-3:30pm. (7 hours/day for a total of 28 hours for the week).

Work Location: The majority of work will take place at the Gustavus Public Library. Some activities may take place outdoors next to the library. There may be limited offsite tasks, such as distributing flyers to the school or town bulletin boards.
