**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS ADOPTING THE
LOCAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus recognizes the threat that local natural hazards pose to people and property; and,

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation projects before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and,


WHEREAS, an adopted Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan has been sent to the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency for their review and preapproval;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Gustavus City Council, hereby adopts the City of Gustavus Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Gustavus will submit the adopted Local Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.
