**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS IN SUPPORT OF THE
GUSTAVUS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT'S REQUEST TO BYPASS THE
COMPETATIVE BID PROCESS**

WHEREAS, City of Gustavus Ordinance 4.16.030 (b) Competitive Bidding allows for bypass of competitive bids by City Council resolutions, and

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Volunteer Fire Department (GVFD) seeks to replace its obsolete tanker truck known as "The Beast," which is unreliable, unsafe to operate, difficult to maintain, and non-compliant with Department of Transportation standards, and

WHEREAS, the GVFD Fire Chief has submitted for Council approval a scoping document (attached) for a project to replace the obsolete tanker truck with a suitable tanker truck to be selected by the Fire Chief this spring from such apparatus offered on the used fire equipment market, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief will be available to inspect and select from suitable offers during scheduled business travel this spring, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief expects such equipment to cost up to \$15,000, with up to \$4000 for freight to Gustavus, and









WHEREAS, the purchase of such apparatus from a field of equipment of various ages, specifications, and conditions is not amenable to the competitive bid process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Gustavus City Council supports the request by the GVFD to bypass the competitive bid process for the purchase of a suitable used tanker truck with the following conditions.

- 1) The equipment selected shall meet the general description as described in the project scoping form for this project,
2. The total price including freight to Gustavus shall not exceed \$19,000.
3. The Fire Chief shall submit a description of the selected apparatus including the asking price and expected shipping costs to Gustavus and shall submit that description to the Mayor in writing by email.

4. The Mayor shall approve the purchase on behalf of the City of Gustavus before any purchasing contract for the apparatus may be agreed and signed.
