**A Resolution Approving the Submission of a Capital Improvement Funding Request for Planning for a new Model of Waste Handling in Gustavus**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center serves Gustavus as a model Integrated Resource Recovery and Waste Disposal Facility, and

**WHEREAS**, the existing permitted landfill space will be filled within fifteen years, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gustavus is planning for the long term efficient and environmentally responsible handling of its waste stream, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gustavus anticipates participating in the South East Alaska Solid Waste Authority, and


**WHEREAS**, The City of Gustavus must plan now for the eventual conversion to a new model comprising recycling, composting, and waste transfer station, and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Gustavus seeks to use a professional consultant to create a model facility that will serve long into the future.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Gustavus City Council approves the CIP funding request to the 2012 Alaska Legislature in the amount of \$30,000 for planning for a new model of waste handling in Gustavus, and urges the Legislature and Governor to consider it favorably.


