**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS TO REORGANIZE
THE GUSTAVUS BEACH COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, City of Gustavus Resolution No. 2010-12 was adopted April 8, 2010, to address the issue of motorized access to the Gustavus beach area; and,

WHEREAS, a special committee called the Gustavus Beach Committee was formed to address said issue of motorized access to the Gustavus beach area but was unable to resolve the issue with the State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources, the manager of said beach area; and,

WHEREAS, certain committee members have resigned through the process used by the City Council and the remaining members have met in a public meeting and voted to nominate a new chairman; and,

WHEREAS, the remaining members have also voted in a public meeting and submitted to the City Council a Committee Request for an Agenda Item to expand the Beach Committee duties to include litter control, restrooms, signage and improvements connected with the beach and continue to work towards resolving the issue of motorized access; and,


WHEREAS, the Gustavus Beach Committee will continue to communicate with the City Council and must have approval from the City Council before any physical change, removal or addition to the beach area begins;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the special committee known as the Gustavus Beach Committee shall reorganize with the expanded duties listed above and serve in an advisory capacity to the Gustavus City Council.




