RESOLUTION 2014-15**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS SETTING RATES FOR
TRANSIENT MOORAGE AT THE SMALL VESSEL FLOAT SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the facility located at the Gustavus Multi-Modal Marine Facility known as the Small Vessel Float System is owned, operated and maintained by the City of Gustavus, and

WHEREAS, agreements between the various funding agencies including the Alaska Department of Transportation and the City of Gustavus, for the construction of the Small Vessel Float System include stipulations that the City of Gustavus will be responsible for the safe and efficient use and orderly management, maintenance and eventual replacement of said facilities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus passed Resolution 2012-11 on May 10, 2012, establishing fees for the facility, and

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Marine Facilities Committee has passed by motion, a change to the fees for transient vessels, said fees to be determined by the length of the vessel, except vessels over 60 feet in length are not permitted on the floats, and now therefore be it


RESOLVED, that the Gustavus City Council approved the change to transient vessel fees as follows:

Small Vessel Float System

A. Transient Vessel shall be defined as any vessel using the Gustavus Small Vessel Float System that has not registered with the City and purchased a yearly use fee sticker.

Vessel Length	Charge per day
Vessels up to 30 feet	\$10.00 per day
Vessels 31 feet to 50 feet	\$15.00 per day
Vessels 51 feet to 60 feet	\$25.00 per day
Vessels over 60 feet	Not Permitted on Floats
Skiffs	\$5.00 per day


