

Resolution of the City of Gustavus, Alaska
RESOLUTION NO. 2006 - 02

A RESOLUTION in support of a grant application to the Denali Commission by the Gustavus Disposal and Recycling Center (DRC), a department of the City of Gustavus, for the purchase of equipment and the construction of infrastructure to facilitate the storage, recycling, and safe disposal of scrap metal, universal waste and household hazardous waste. The proposed grant would also allow for the construction of a ADEC approved burn box for wood waste disposal and a small in-vessel composter for the processing of restaurant grease trap waste.

WHEREAS, the Gustavus DRC has accumulated a substantial quantity of scrap metal and other materials to be shipped for recycling, and;


WHEREAS, the Gustavus DRC is seeking to purchase equipment and materials to facilitate processing and shipping of such materials on a regular basis so as to eliminate future stockpiles, and;






