**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Gustavus have placed a water testing program for safe drinking water as a priority on the Strategic Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, according to that same Strategic Plan, the citizens of Gustavus have asked that a watershed quality council be created; and

**WHEREAS**, according to that same Strategic Plan, the citizens of Gustavus have also expressed the desire to foster appreciation for the history, traditions and heritage of Gustavus as it exists within the greater Icy Strait area and develop a community cemetery; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lands Selection Committee is familiar with the lands available for these purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lands Selection Committee will serve in conjunction with the Community Strategic Planning Committee to be responsible for developing a formalized process for selecting these lands now and in the future;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council supports the reclassification of the Lands Selection Committee from a special committee to a standing committee of the City of Gustavus called the Lands Committee.


