RESOLUTION No. 2006-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS, ALASKA, CREATING PENALTIES AND FEES FOR DUMPING OR DISCARDING TANGIBLE PROPERTY AT OR UPON THE SALMON RIVER BOAT HARBOR AREA AND FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus has adopted Harbor Ordinances which include provision for fees and penalties; and

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Strategic Plan states that clean up of the Salmon River Boat Harbor is a top priority; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to remove derelict and nuisance property for the upcoming launch ramp/ramp barge landing construction and to provide a designated area for parking and freight staging; and

WHEREAS, improper dumping or discarding of property is a prohibited practice as stated in City of Gustavus Alaska Municipal Code, 8.06.10 and 8.07.3 which states that these practices may be subject to civil penalties, in the amounts established by resolution of the City Council;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the civil penalty for failure to remove tangible property from the Salmon River Boat Harbor is \$50 for each item of tangible property. Penalties begin to accrue one week from the date that written notice is mailed to the owner of the property. Each day upon which the violation occurs or continues to occur constitutes a separate offense, up to a maximum of \$300 for each item of property. The civil penalty assessed by this resolution is in addition to any costs associated with the removal and disposal of the property.






