

**Resolution of the City of Gustavus, Alaska
Resolution No. 2008-10**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE GUSTAVUS CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING
THE TRANSFER OF LEGISLATIVE GRANT FUNDS TO DEPARTMENT
OF TRANSPORTATION & PUBLIC FCILITIES**

Throughout this document Grant Funds refer to the 'FY 2009 Legislative Fund Grant 09-DC-473' in the amount of \$61,808.00 for completion of the project 'Ten foot Oval Culvert at Wilson Road/State Gravel Pit Crossing' heretofore referred to as the 'Rink Creek Road Culvert Project'

WHEREAS, the City of Gustavus has received a 2009 Legislative Grant of \$61,808.00 for completion of a culvert project on Rink Creek Road near the Alaska State owned gravel pit, and

WHEREAS, the funds allotted by the Alaska State Legislature are insufficient to complete all phases of the project due to costs of materials, design, engineering, permitting, advertising and project management, and

WHEREAS, within the community of Gustavus funds are insufficient and expertise inadequate to provide for materials, design, engineering, permitting, advertising and project management, and


WHEREAS, Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities wishes to use this culvert project for mitigation of Gustavus Causeway Project construction and has funds available for proper completion of this project, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is amenable to use a City/State team approach to provide for the completion of this project, and

WHEREAS, Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, the manager of these funds, has agreed to transfer the FY 2009 Legislative Fund Grant 09-DC-473 in the amount of \$61,808.00 to DOT for the purpose of project completion,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Gustavus requests DCCED to transfer the Legislative Grant Funds to DOT to mingle this grant with State and Federal funds as necessary to complete all phases of the Rink Creek Road Culvert Project.


