**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSAL TO 'UPGRADE
LIBRARY TECHNOLOGY' FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF
ALASKA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Public Library is at the center of the community and serves as the main access point to the Internet for many members of the community;

WHEREAS, the Gustavus Public Library also houses the server for the Gustavus Community Network's internet service and is the base from which GCN provides service to the Gustavus School and the rest of the community;

WHEREAS, the GCN server is now outdated and in need of replacement;

WHEREAS, the 4 public computers available to library patrons are inadequate in number resulting in long waiting times and reduced privacy;

WHEREAS, other deficiencies, such as lack of backup hard drives, inefficient connections to a copier/printer/scanner, lack of privacy screens and lack of disc cleaning equipment, have also been identified as being in need of upgrades;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Gustavus City Council, in an effort to improve the performance, reliability, security and capacity of library and city information systems by upgrading workstations, servers, software and equipment, supports for submission the proposal 'Upgrade Library Technology' for a CIP grant.
