## CITY OF GUSTAVUS, ALASKA RESOLUTION 2009-23

## A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TERMINAL BUILDING AT THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED GUSTAVUS DOCK.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gustavus was successful in obtaining an earmark from Alaska's Washington delegation for Alaska Marine Highway-designated funding for Gustavus, and;

**WHEREAS**, the construction bid for the new dock facility came in below the engineer's estimated budget, thereby creating an excess in dedicated funds, and;

**WHEREAS**, Alaska Department of Transportation has offered to build a terminal building with those excess dedicated funds, and;

**WHEREAS**, the eventual scheduling of an Alaska Marine Highway Ferry into Gustavus will require a terminal facility, and;

**WHEREAS**, Alaska Department of Transportation is highly favorable to the City of Gustavus using part of terminal building's space for City functions, i.e. the City Clerk's office and a city meeting place, and;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the city council of the City of Gustavus supports the construction, operation and maintenance of a Gustavus ferry terminal/city office building and The City of Gustavus will have the building open with priority use by AMHS when a vessel is in port - upon agreement and signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with Alaska Department of Transportation.
