A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF GUSTAVUS IN SUPPORT OF POSTING AS 11.61.195 MISCONDUCT INVOLVING WEAPONS IN THE SECOND DEGREE AND AS 11.61.210 MISCONDUCT INVOLVING WEAPONS IN THE FOURTH DEGREE

WHEREAS, many citizens of Gustavus are very concerned with the safety of person and property in the conjunction with the illegal discharge of fire arms, and;


WHEREAS, there have been several serious incidents involving the illegal discharge of fire arms in residential areas, near the school and across roads, and;

WHEREAS, the signs will read: THE DISCHARGE OF FIRE ARMS PROHIBITED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALASKA STATUTES AS 11.61.195 AND AS 11.61.210, AND SUPPORTED BY CITY OF GUSTAVUS RESOLUTION 2009-26.

WHEREAS, copies of the statutes and this resolution will be made available at City Hall and be available at the classes for hunters provided by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game prior to each hunting season.

AND NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Gustavus City Council supports this resolution to stop the illegal discharge of firearms within the city.




